MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3, 2019 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present Schellhammer, Byrnes and Koenig. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.

Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

19.301-Motion Byrnes/Second Koenig to approve today's agenda and the minutes from August 26, 2019. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Board of Supervisors, Tom Blake, John Ellingson, Val Reinke, Corey Snitker, Brian Ridenour.

Public Comment: John Ellingson informed Supervisors of an item on the City Council agenda tonight regarding activity near 16th Ave NW/Green Valley Road area. Val Reinke shared listing of local events for September, including the Corn Maze event at Waukon Feed Ranch this weekend.

Tom Blake explained recommended changes to the Form A application for land division. The form is being simplified and will be valid for 120 days instead of 90 days.

19.302-Motion Byrnes/Second Koenig to approve changes to Form A as presented. Motion carried.

19.303-Motion Koenig/Second Byrnes to appoint Andy Kelleher as Director and Val Reinke as Alternate for Eastern Iowa Tourism Association. Motion carried.

19.304-Motion Byrnes/Second Koenig to approve the Certificate of Adjustment for Croell Redi-Mix, Inc. Motion carried.

19.305-Motion Koenig/Second Byrnes to proclaim September 2019 as National Voter Registration Month and Tuesday, September 24, 2019 as National Voter Registration Day. Motion carried.

19.306-Motion Koenig/Second Byrnes to set Monday, September 23, 2019 at 9:40 am for the Public Hearing for FY20 Allamakee County budget amendment. Motion carried.

Engineer Ridenour reviewed the Eng-

lish Bench Watershed Site #9 issues and timeline and presented a letter to NRCS with questions regarding the permanent repairs to Site #9. Mark McCurdy with NRCS indicated to Engineer Ridenour that expenses should be 100% NRCS, no County match/expense.

19.307-Motion Koenig/Second Byrnes to approve signing the letter to NRCS for repairs to the English Bench Site #9. Motion carried.

Ridenour recommended changes to intersection signage.

19.308-Motion Byrnes/Second Koenig to approve resolution for a stop sign at Hartong Drive and Schweinfurth Road intersection. Roll call: Koenig-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)

Department head updates: Supervisor Schellhammer informed Engineer Ridenour about the issue mentioned during public comment regarding 16th Ave NW/Green Valley Road area. Supervisors will plan a meeting later in the week to view the issue in the area. Engineer Ridenour gave department update and informed Board that road closure for Dorchester Drive will start Wednesday, Sept 4 for culvert repair. Corey Snitker informed Board that September is Preparedness Month, and updated on upcoming meetings and events. Tom Blake gave an update on permit issued for structure south of Lansing, with a variance granted, but a larger structure was put in and neighbors field appeal with Board of Adjustment. Depending on how the appeal hearing goes, the neighbors could appeal to District Court. Also Blake informed Board that Dennis Keatley will not be seeking another term on Board of Adjustments. Auditor Beyer stated her new employee starts today, and her office is gearing up for the November 5 City/School election. Koenig gave CSS arbitration update.
