aney, Brian Ridenour. Public Comment: Val Reinke reviewed weekend events and upcoming events and meetings.

Attorney Tony Gericke requested permission to request an Attorney General's opinion- asking them to look at an old opinion from 1979 and update as needed. Opinion is regarding liability of the county for any hospital debt. He feels the 1979 opinion is contradictory to the current Iowa Code. 23.074-Motion Reiser/Second

vember 20. Motion carried. Jane Regan from the Compensation Board shared their process for determining the FY24 salaries of elected officials and thanked the Allamakee County elected officials. Regan presented their FY24 salary recommendations for elected officials as follows: 10% increase for Treasurer, Recorder, Auditor, Attorney and Supervisors; and 12%

Chair Byrnes discussed the Supervisors choice to reduce their 10% recommendation to 2.5% increase, as they work through the budget process. The Supervisors can adjust their recommendation at a different rate than other elected officials, but it has to be done at least 30 days before the budget hearing/other elected official sala-

ries are voted on. 23.076-Motion Keatley/Second Reiser to approve resolution for FY24 salary for Board of Supervisors at \$30,220, a 2.5% increase, or a reduction of 75% in the Compensation Board recommendation. Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Keatley-aye. Motion carried.

Department Head updates: Engineer Ridenour commented on salaries and increases in prices of everything, and providing salaries to get candidates to apply for jobs. Ridenour also gave update on an intersection project and other projects and 6-county meeting on Thursday in Decorah. Jim Janett gave project update on aquarium being installed at Visitor Center, after a \$75,000 fundraising effort by the Conservation Foundation, Auditor Beyer gave department up-
