21.080-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve today's agenda and minutes from February 15, 18 and 19, 2021. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person or via Zoom: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Jon Luchsinger, Clark Mellick, Corey Snitker, Laurie Moody, Stephanie Runkle, Mandy O'Neill.

Public Comment: None. Sheriff Mellick asked for approval for a purchase with county card.

21.081-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve use of County credit card by Sheriff's office in amount of \$39.74 to purchase evidence tape. Motion carried. Auditor Beyer informed Supervisors the lease for current postage machine expires on 4/4/21 and presented new lease.

21.082-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve the new 60-month lease for new Postage machine including lease and maintenance at \$223.27/month. Motion carried.

Supervisor Schellhammer started discussion on a possible stipend for Mandy O'Neill. Supervisors recognized Mandy O'Neill's efforts to learn and fill in for Planning & Zoning, including evening meetings and said she did a good job in this role

following Tom Blake's retirement November 30 until now.
