Public Comment: Val Reinke reported on events the past week including 4th of July activities. Postville Farmers Market starts this Thursday with live music and the taco truck. Schellhammer reported the Nightingale Drug Open House event was well attended. Heartland Barber Shop and Gospel Singers will be at the Waukon Music in the Park this week. Laurie Moody received a com-

ment that there is a noxious weed that is protected in Allamakee, but she has heard nothing in regard to that and recommends moving forward with resolution as is. Moody has letters going out to landowners regarding some common weeds that need attention

Resolution #21.244 RESOLUTION FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF NOXIOUS

WEEDS

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Allamakee County, Iowa;

That pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 317 Code of Iowa, 2021, it is hereby ordered:

1. That each owner and each person in the possession or control of any lands in Allamakee County shall properly spray, cut, burn, or oth-erwise destroy all noxious weeds thereon, as defined in this chapter, at such time in each year and in such manner as shall prevent said weeds from blooming or coming to maturity, and shall keep their lands free from such growth of any weeds as shall render the streets or highways adjoining said land unsafe for public travel. Noxious weeds shall be cut or otherwise destroyed on or before the following dates as often thereafter as it is necessary to prevent seed production: PRIMARY NOXIOUS WEEDS:

JULY 15, 2021 for Buckthorn, Bull thistle, Canada thistle, Field bind-Hoary cress (Perennial weed. pepper-grass) Horse nettle, Leafy spurge, musk thistle, Perennial sow thistle, Quack grass, Russian knapweed, Tall thistle & Palmer amaranth

SECONDARY NOXIOUS WEEDS: JULY 15, 2021 for Buckthorn plantain, Cocklebur, Wild er curlv dock Poiso nem lock, Puncturevine, Sheep sorrel, Sour dock, Smooth dock, Teasel,

Velvetleaf (Butterprint), Wild carrot, Wild mustard, Multiflora rose and Shattercane.

2. That each owner or each person in the possession or control of land in Allamakee County infested with any noxious weeds shall be expected to destroy and will immediately keep such infestations of said noxious weeds destroyed to prevent the weeds from blooming and maturing additional seeds.

3. That if the owners or persons in possession or control of any land in Allamakee County fail to comply with the foregoing orders, the Weed Commissioner shall cause this to be done and the expense of said work, including cost of serving notice and other cost, if any, shall be assessed against the land and its owners thereof.

4. The multiflora rose shall not be considered a noxious weed when cultivated for or used as undersod for cultivated roses or as ornamental shrubs in gardens, per Iowa Code Section 317 1 (2)

That the Allamakee County Auditor is hereby directed to cause notice of the making and entering of foregoing order by on publication in each of the official newspapers of the County.

Gericke reviewed the breakdown of the funds the County gets for the collections done by the attorney's staff. The extra 5% received after the annual threshold is met has been going to the General Fund and the County Attorney looked into it and the extra 5% should be going into an Attorney's Fund. Records reflect \$10,424 would have gone to a special Attorney's Collection Fund over the most recent 5 years, ignoring years prior to 2017. Gericke requested that the \$10,424 be transferred from the General Fund balance to the newly created Attorney's Collection Fund.

Department Head/COVID-19 updates: Stephanie Runkle informed Supervisors she has had questions about private burials on private land and Assistant County Attorney Kistler recommends making a new ordinance regarding private burials on private land. Corey Snitker gave updates on weather, upcoming county fair. tractorcade. commission meeting, upcoming UERPC Resiliency meetings. Engineer Ridenour gave department and project updates including repair of washouts after the heavy rains a week and a half ago. Schellhammer informed Ridenour about ditch mowing comments. Auditor Beyer gave updates on the CSS levy being lowered by legislation, 28E agreements for contributions to non-profits, and told Supervisors if they wish to pursue electronic time tracking options to let her know to put it on agenda for discussion. Schellhammer stated that prior services for transports for autopsies have been discontinued and there will likely be future meetings with city, county and hospital regarding autopsy transports.
