MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, AUGUST 16, 2021 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes, Reiser and Schellhammer. All members voting "AYE" unless noted. Meeting held at Harpers Ferry City Hall/Public Library.

Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

21.304-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve today's agenda and the minutes from August 9, 2021. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Val Reinke, Jim Janett, Brian Ridenour, Stephanie Runkle, Jody Delaney.

Public Comment: Val Reinke gave update on booth at Iowa State Fair and upcoming events including Waukon Corn Days event and Waterville Country on the Creek; emailed the newest laborshed report from Iowa Workforce Development; informed of Rural Development Summit at Kirkwood College this week; explained the Postville Heart and Soul Community Building group purpose and plan. Jim Janett reported on attendance at Driftless Visitor Center and a donation made toward a commercial fishing display.

21.305-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to accept and place on file Manure Management Plans for Martins Site and Millerway. Motion carried.

Library update tabled until department head updates.

Stephanie Runkle explained the state law allowing private burials on private property and gave a copy of a drafted ordinance.

21.306-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to set public hearing for Private Burial Ordinance on August 30, 2021 at 9:40am. Motion carried.

Engineer Ridenour presented a letter from Allamakee Soil and Water Conservation – landowner, George Beardmore, wants to do improvements on a watershed and pay the expenses themselves. Ridenour explained what improvements will be made to English Bench Watershed Sites 3, 7 and 8.

21.307-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to sign Letter of Agreement to allow work on English Bench Watershed structures. Motion carried.

Engineer presented Contract and Bond for concrete pavement patching.

21.308-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve Cedar Falls Construction Company Contract and Bond for concrete pavement patching. Motion carried.

Department Head/COVID-19 updates: Auditor Beyer gave update on tax statements. Engineer Ridenour gave department update, update on application deadline for department openings and update on recently replaced and opened Cota Creek bridge just outside Harpers Ferry. Next 6-county meeting will be in Allamakee and a date and location needs to be set, looking at September 2 with location to be determined. Mark Reiser asked about ditch mowing progress and types of mowers used. Librarian Jody Delaney with Harpers Ferry Dolores Tillinghast Library gave an update on programming, and library use during and after the pandemic.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. LX

The Allamakee County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing for the first reading of Ordinance LX – Regulation of the Burial of Human Remains Outside of Cemeteries within Allamakee County, Iowa. The public hearing will be held during the Board of Supervisors meeting in the Board of Supervisors room at 110 Allamakee St, Waukon, IA 52172 on Monday, August 30, 2021 at 9:40 A.M. A summary of Ordinance LX follows:

- 1) PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the regulation of burials of human remains when the burial is not within an established cemetery as defined by Iowa Code 5231. This Iowa Code section may require Allamakee County to be responsible for preservation and protection of such burial sites and it is therefore in the interest of Allamakee County to regulate this activity.
- 2) DEFINITIONS. Words used in this ordinance shall have the same

definitions as those provided in Iowa 5231.102

3) GENERAL REQUIREMENTS. Burials not in a cemetery as defined in Iowa Code 5231.102(6) are prohibited unless the following conditions are met:

- a. A written Agreement is made by the owner of the property on which the burial is to occur accepting responsibility for the preservation and protections of the burial site in perpetuity. Proof of ownership or control of the burial site shall be provided.
- b. The Agreement shall be approved as to form by the Allamakee County Attorney.
- c. The Agreement shall state that Allamakee county shall not in the future be held responsible for preservation or protection of the burial site.
- d. The Agreement shall include a map showing the location of the burial site.
- e. The Agreement shall include a binding plan for preservation or protection of the burial site.

f. Each Agreement shall be approved by action of the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors.

g. Each Agreement shall be recorded in the office of the Allamakee County Recorder as an easement for use of the land of the land as a burial site.

4) PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. Failure to comply with any provision of this ordinance shall be declared unlawful.

a. Injunction and Abatement. The County, through its authorized agents, may initiate injunction or abatement proceedings or other appropriate action in the Court of competent jurisdiction against any person who fails to comply with any provision of this ordinance. The County may seek a court order in the nature of mandamus, abatement, injunction or other action or proceeding to abate or remove a violation.
