Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

21.328-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve today's agenda and the minutes from August 30, 2021. Motion carried.

Department Head/COVID-19 updates: Corey Snitker gave COVID-19 updates regarding the state COVID-19 website; asked where the county stands with mask and quarantine requirements and it was consensus that we follow the CDC guidelines. Snitker informed Supervisors that ages 17 and under is the age range that has the highest positivity rate at this time and October is Fire Prevention month.
