ORDINANCE NO. 704-22 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING **CHAPTER 75 (ALL-TERRAIN** VEHICLES, OFF ROAD UTILITY VEHICLES, SNOWMOBILES AND GOLF CARTS) OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POSTVILLE, IOWA: SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The pur-

pose of this ordinance is to amend certain provisions of Chapter 75 of the City Code to take advantage of the recent changes to the Iowa Code regarding the operation of utility vehicles ("UTV") and allow the citizens of Postville, Iowa to operate UTVs and similar equipment on City streets unless otherwise designated by the City Council.

To further effectuate the City's purpose above, certain sections of the City Code of Ordinances must be amended and/or added to provide for the efficient regulation of UTV and similar equipment operation within the city limits of Postville, Iowa,

SECTION 2. SECTIONS AMEND-ED. Chapter 75 is hereby amended as follows, with underlined text indicating language added and struck through language indicating removal:

CHAPTER 75 ALL-TERRAIN VEHILCES, OFF ROAD UTILITY VEHICLES, SNOWMOBILES AND GOLF CARTS

75.04 PLACES OF OPERATION 1. The operators of ATVS and snowmobiles shall comply with the following restrictions as to where they may be operated within the

City: A. Unplowed Streets. Snowmobiles shall be operated only upon streets which have not been

plowed during the snow season and on any other streets except any street which is a state or fed-

eral highway. B. Streets. ATVS may be operated on any public streets within the City according to the route as allowed by resolution of the City Council and where signs have been erected designating allowable streets along the route. unless otherwise deemed prohibited by resolution of the City Council. Operation of ATVs on streets within the City is also subject to the requirements of Section 321.234A of the Code of Iowa. Persons operating ATVs Crossing of state highways on the designated route must receive Iowa Department of Transportation approval prior to crossing state highways. to

such travel.
SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law PASSED AND APPROVED this 12th day of September 2022. Dennis Koenig, Mayor

Public Comment: Lynn Strong

asked Supervisors when they would be getting the remainder of the rock they agreed to get from their quarry as it will be shutting down in November. Val Reinke reviewed past events and previewed upcoming community events and meetings, including an EV "Charged Up" event on October 13 at NICC in Calmar.

John Roe reported a verbal quote from Glen Palmer of \$3,500 for wall in server room. Auditor Beyer requested he get the quote in writing. 22.342-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve quote from Palmer Repair for \$3,500 to put up a wall in the server room with funds coming from Courthouse Services budget. Motion carried. Discussion was held on County IT.

Ann Burckart reported that when the Assessor's office took over IT she was told that it would take 2 hours per week, then it became 6 hours per week. It is becoming more and taking close to half of Jon Luchsinger's time. The recent request by Commissioner of Elections Beyer to have someone on call the entire Election Day has created awareness that IT is becoming more than part-time. Burckart asked that the Supervisors consider hiring a full-time IT person when budgeting for FY23-24. She is willing to keep it in her office until July 1, 2023. Supervisors asked Jon Luchsinger to start to lay out what duties the new position would be responsible for. Discussion was held on which Solutions services currently used by the County, including Sheriff's office and E-911, would be continued if a full-time IT person is hired.

Jill Kistler asked for approval for a grant award to fund additional salary for her position - 2023 Byrne JAG Award. Kistler works full-time and the county funds part-time salary and she gets grants for the gap between part-time and full-time pay. The current Byrne JAG grant is through December 2022, and Kistler is hearing that January 2023 will also be funded. This new grant will be for February 2023 - June 30, 2023, but she has listed January through June 30, 2023 in case some of this grant is needed to fund January. Kistler requested approval of salary increase of \$13,695 for January 2023 through June 2023

for Assistant County Attorney salary, with 75% to be reimbursed by grant and 25% county match.

22.343-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve the Byrne JAG contract and conditions for January 2023 through June 2023, which includes a salary increase of \$13,695 for Assistant County Attorney Jill Kistler for that time period. Motion carried.

Auditor Beyer went over in detail the Title VI and ADA requirements and the need to appoint Title VI and ADA Coordinators by resolution.

No action taken today.
Department Head updates: Sheriff Mellick gave department update and discussed options for some-thing to replace the current signal receivers on the current water tower at PSC if the water tower needs to come down.
