MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2021 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes, Reiser and Schellhammer. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.

Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

21.342-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve today's agenda and the minutes from September 20, 2021. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Val Reinke, Stephanie Runkle, Duane Leppert, Jill Kistler, Darin Svenson, Mandy O'Neill, Jill Kistler, Laurie Moody, Jon Luchsinger, Brian Ridenour, Tony Gericke, Corey Snitker, Michael Coyle.

Public Comment: Val Reinke reported on upcoming events in the County and encouraged Supervisors to read about the upcoming development in Waukon. The Lansing ATV/UTV ride reported 426 units. Tonight there is a meeting about the Lansing BlackHawk bridge replacement project.

21.343-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to open public hearing for Private Burial Ordinance. Motion carried.

Stephanie Runkle gave an update on the language changes – adding language for requiring a concrete liner; the language of "human remains" includes ashes/cremation remains. Jill Kistler spoke about the need for this ordinance for regulation and records purposes. If there is no plan for preservation, the duty falls back on the county to preserve and protect the burial sites. Enforcement was discussed - there may be burials the county is not made aware of, but once the ordinance is in force, the county is not

responsible for private burials. Periodic review will be done to address additional issues that may come up.

21.344-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to close public hearing for Private Burial Ordinance. Motion carried.

21.345-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve first reading of Private Burial Ordinance. Motion carried.

Runkle presented the subdivision plats for approval.

21.346-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve the resolution of acceptance of final subdivision plat for Joseph T & Joshua P Teff (Lot 3 in NW Qtr of ...). Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditors office)

21.347-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve the resolution of acceptance of final subdivision plat for Joseph T & Joshua P Teff (Lot 4 in NW Qtr of ...). Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditors office)

21.348-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve the resolution of acceptance of final subdivision plat for Myron Valley Property. Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditors office)

Engineer Ridenour reviewed the project that bids will be taken for today.

Byrnes opened the single bid received from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, LLC. Bid read as \$384,194.40.

This is over Engineer's estimate. Ridenour will review the bid and present a recommendation at a future meeting.

Ridenour recommends hiring Cory Huinker as Maintenance Person II starting October 18 at the union contract rate.

21.349-Motion Reiser/Second

Byrnes to approve hiring Cory Huinker as Maintenance Person II starting October 18 at the union rate of \$21.04/hour for Secondary Road department. Motion carried.

Attorney Tony Gericke notified Supervisors of application for Civil Service Commission appointment.

21.350-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve attorney's appointment of Connie Schneden to Civil Service Commission for remainder of 6-year term (starting 2019). Motion carried.

Tony Gericke has provided 28E agreements for six more non-profit organizations as recommended by the State Auditor to allow county contributions to the non-profits.

21.351-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve six 28E agreements between Allamakee County and the following non-profit organizations: Northeast Iowa Area Agency on Aging, Northeast Iowa Resource Conservation and Development, Retired Senior and Volunteer Program, Riverview Center, Helping Services, Allamakee Soil & Water Conservation District. Motion carried.

Michael Coyle, Veterans Memorial Hospital Administrator provided information related to a request for the county to allocate some of the county's American Rescue Plan dollars to a new mental health clinic. Coyle provided statistics and a spreadsheet showing trends of a higher number of mental health patients – many seeking care in another city/county. Some people don't seek care because of the stigma of mental health issues, lack of trained providers, can't afford mental health care, or lack of accessibility or transportation to get care. Coyle explained that VMH is working with a company to provide mental health services at the VMH clinic. The location of new Behavioral Health Clinic would be in the current VMH clinic, with a more private entrance being created at the

current employee entrance. Coyle provided a plan for renovation of this entrance, 3 offices and a waiting room and a small group meeting room, and he gave a plan for hiring mental health professionals. This location gives the opportunity to treat both the mental side and the physical side of the issue also, in the adjoining clinic. Coyle requested an amount of \$380,000 to cover the renovation and equipping of the clinic. Working with the schools and technology costs were discussed. Supervisors expressed their initial thoughts about the request and department heads and Supervisors will be meeting to discuss requests and options for allocating the American Rescue Plan funds. Schellhammer gave a timeline of end of October to have an answer to Michael Coyle and the hospital on funding.

Department Head/COVID-19 updates: Corey Snitker shared COVID stats from the state website: 47 positives in Allamakee County within 7 days prior to Sept 22; gave booster vaccine information update. Snitker shared information on upcoming meetings and events and the courthouse fire drill on October 5 at 9:00am. Engineer Ridenour reminded Supervisors of the Lansing Blackhawk Bridge meeting to night and next week the roads crew goes back to 5-day workweek and gave project update. Auditor Beyer discussed meeting time for American Rescue Plan with Supervisors and Department Heads and Paul Berland and Monday, October 4 at 11:00am.
