**Voter ID:** Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered-such as voters registering to vote on Election Day-and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required): 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by 12:00 (Noon) Monday, November 8. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. ## PUBLIC NOTICE

### ORDINANCE NO. LX COUNTY ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BURIAL OF HUMAN REMAINS OUTSIDE OF CEMETERIES WITHIN ALLAMAKEE COUNTY, IOWA BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

**SECTION 1. TITLE**  
This Ordinance shall be known as and may be cited and referred to as the County Ordinance Regulating the Burial of Human Remains Outside of Cemeteries within Allamakee County, Iowa.

### SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide for the regulation of burials of human remains when the burial is not within an established cemetery as defined by the Iowa Cemetery Act/Iowa Code Chapter 523I. Iowa Code Chapter 523I may require Allamakee County to be responsible for the preservation and protection of such burial sites outside of established cemeteries, and it is therefore in the best interest of Allamakee County to regulate this activity.

### SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS

Words used in this Ordinance shall have the same definitions as those defined in Iowa Code §523I.102.

### SECTION 4. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Burials not in a cemetery as defined in Iowa Code 523I.102(6) are prohibited unless all of the following conditions are met:

a. A written agreement is entered into between Allamakee County and the owner(s) of the property on which the burial is to occur in which the property owner accepts responsibility for the preservation and protection of the burial site in

perpetuity.  
b. Proof of ownership and control of the burial site shall be provided by the property owner to Allamakee County prior to consideration of entry into any agreement.

c. The Agreement shall be approved as to form and content by the Allamakee County Attorney.

d. The Agreement shall certify that Allamakee County shall not now or in the future be held responsible for preservation or protection of the burial site.

e. The Agreement shall include a map showing the exact location of the burial site.

f. The Agreement shall include a binding plan for the preservation and protection of the burial site that requires a minimum of a concrete liner and 4-foot burial depth for interred remains.

g. The Agreement must be approved by action of the Allamakee County Board of Supervisors by an affirmative vote of not less than a majority of the supervisors. Each supervisor's vote on an Agreement entered pursuant to this Ordinance shall be recorded.

h. Each Agreement entered into pursuant to this Ordinance shall be promptly recorded by the property owner, at the property owner's expense, in the office of the Allamakee County Recorder as an easement for use of the land as a burial site.

### SECTION 5. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Failure to comply with any provision of this Ordinance shall be declared unlawful, and punished civilly or criminally.

a. Injunction and Abatement. The County, through its authorized agents, may initiate injunction or abatement proceedings or other

appropriate action in the Court of competent jurisdiction against any person who fails to comply with any provision of this Ordinance. The County may seek a court order in the nature of mandamus, abatement, injunction or other action or proceeding to abate or remove a violation.

b. A violation of this Ordinance may be punished civilly through imposition of a civil penalty not to exceed \$750.00 per violation, with each day of a continuing violation constituting a separate violation.

c. A violation of this Ordinance may also be punished criminally with the criminal penalty not to exceed the maximum fine and term of imprisonment for a simple misdemeanor under Iowa Code § 903.1(1)(a), and with each day of a continuing violation constituting a separate violation.

### SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of either the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

### SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption, and publication as required by law.
