Meeting was called to order by Byrnes.
25.369- Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve today's agenda and minutes from October 20, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.
Present at different times throughout the meeting: Joseph Moses – Waukon Standard, Denise Beyer – Clerk to Supervisors, Claire Opperman, Roger Mohn, Mike Hohenbrink – Postville Herald, Clark Mellick, Karson Hennings, Amy Bresnahan, Dave Mooney.
Public Comment: None
Claire Opperman presented plat for approval.
25.370-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to approve resolution of subdivision plat for Mary Wachter Estate et al. Roll call: Clark-aye; Byrnes-aye; Keatley-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)
25.371-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve appointing Jim Magner and George Beardmore to the Historic Preservation Commission with terms expiring 12/31/2027. Motion carried.
Clark Mellick and Roger Mohn presented a change order for Kelly Concrete – the original proposal was for \$10,835 but Mohn neglected to include site preparation on original bid request. Kelly submitted bid of \$1,500 for site prep work. Mohn noted that the total of the original proposal plus the change

Department Head updates: Sheriff Mellick gave department update including talking to Kramer for Black-Hawk bridge demolition about helping with traffic/crowd control the day of bridge demolition. Mellick and Mohn have been talking to Scott Hartong regarding demolition of the existing water tower. Auditor Beyer gave election update for November 4, 2025 City-School election. Dave Mooney reported that a 4% increase was supposed to be effective this week on a contract with Republic sanitation (formerly Town & Country), but Dave negotiated with the company due to lack of service quality and they have agreed to no 4% increase this year.
