25.369- Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve today's agenda and minutes from October 20, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.

Present at different times throughout the meeting: Joseph Moses – Waukon Standard, Denise Beyer Clerk to Supervisors, Claire Opperman, Roger Mohn, Mike Hohenbrink – Postville Herald, Clark Mellick, Karson Hennings, Amy Bresnahan, Dave Mooney Public Comment: None

Claire Opperman presented plat for

approval. 25.370-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to approve resolution of subdivision plat for Mary Wachter Estate et al. Roll call: Clark-aye; Byrnes-aye; Keatley-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)
