MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2022 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Schellhammer, Byrnes and Reiser. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.
 Meeting called to order by Schellhammer.
 22.416-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve today's agenda. Motion carried.
 The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Jeremy Troendle – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Dennis Keatley, Tony Gericke via telephone.
 Schellhammer informed the other supervisors that the Veterans Memorial Hospital attorneys have said that the VMH Board of Trustees that was in place before the public measure passed at the election to

change to a county hospital no longer has legal standing following the canvass of the election on November 15. Also, Matt Goltz will not be able to serve as Trustee due to the new VMH Bylaws and the fact his wife is an employee of the hospital. Today's meeting is to discuss how to move forward. Options discussed: appoint just 4 or 5 Trustees today and then advertise for the 2 or 3 vacant seats; appoint a temporary board for a certain time period, advertise and then appoint a permanent board at the end of that time period. Supervisors called County Attorney Tony Gericke to ask about appointing a temporary Board of Trustees until a certain date and then appointing the permanent trustees on that date. Gericke agreed that temporary appointments with expiration dates when permanent trustees are appointed would be an allowable way to handle the appointments.

 Mark Reiser will need to be appointed to serve as the non-voting member of the VMH Board of Trustees. Schellhammer will continue attending the legal meetings with the City Attorney, County Attorney and VMH Attorneys.

The certified enrollment total count as of October 2022 is 694. Postville's solvency ratio at the end of FY22 was 14.8%. The spending authority ratio is 27.3%. Mr. Knudson announced that Audrey Ruff, who attended the State Thespian Festival, and was selected to be one of five members in the state to serve as an officer of the state Thespian association. Summary ISASP student data was shared and reviewed, along with action steps on how to keep progress moving in a positive direction. Behavior Support Teacher utilizing Federal Title IV and State At-Risk funds. Carried unanimously.

 Motion by Loera, second by Lage, to approve the application to the School Budget Review Committee for the modified supplemental amount of \$129,727.50, for increased enrollment. Carried unanimously.
 Motion by Loera, second by Lage, to approve the application to the School Budget Review Committee for the modified supplemental amount of \$112,455.21, for LEP instruction beyond five years. Carried unanimously.
