MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, NOVEMBER 22, 2021 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes, Reiser and Schellhammer. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.

Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

21.407-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve today's agenda, and the minutes from November 15, 2021. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Janel Eglseder – 1st Deputy Auditor, Kannon and Karena Grotegut, Stephanie Runkle, Laurie Moody, Mandy O'Neill, Clark Mellick, Jacob Dougherty, Janel Eglseder, Deb Winke, Brian Ridenour.

Public Comment: None
21.408-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to open public hearing for Allamakee County FY22 budget amendment. Motion carried.

Auditor Beyer explained the amounts included in the amendment. No other comments.

21.409-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to close public hearing for Allamakee County FY22 budget amendment. Motion carried.

21.410-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to adopt the Allamakee County FY22 budget amendment. Motion carried.

21.411-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to adopt the appropriations resolution for FY22 budget amendment. Motion carried. Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)

Discussion was held regarding Motion 21.395 made November 15 regarding options for county health insurance for spouses both employed by Allamakee County. Clarification was provided that the county contribution must be given toward each employee plan, nothing more or less, regardless of the plan chosen.

21.412-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve the liquor license renewal for Wings. Motion carried.

Supervisors reviewed a new liquor license application for KKG Performance Horses.

21.413-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve new liquor license for KKG Performance Horses. Motion carried.

Auditor Beyer explained the steps taken so far to apply for the County's American Rescue Plan dollars. After the agreement form is signed and submitted today, Beyer should be able to request the ARP funds.

21.414-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve signing the Award Terms & Conditions for Coronavirus State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (American Rescue Plan funds). Motion carried.

21.415-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to accept and place on file the quarterly reports from the Auditor. Motion carried.

21.416-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve the resolution of acceptance of final subdivision plat for Mark J. & Debra J. Palmer. Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)

21.417-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser approve the resolution of acceptance of final subdivision plat for Connie Snitker, Cindy Egan, Charles Wachter and Gary Wach-

ter. Roll call: Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)

Sheriff Mellick shared quotes for a new patrol vehicle: Bids for a truck were from:

RW Pladsen for 2022 Silverado at \$35,500 after \$4,000 trade-in and fleet discount;

Torkelson's for 2022 Ram 1500 at \$32,790 after \$5,500 trade-in and fleet discount.

Due to availability and costs, quotes were also obtained for an SUV from:

RW Pladsen for 2022 Chevy Tahoe at \$36,500 after \$4,000 trade-in and fleet discount;

Torkelson's for 2022 Durango at \$33,190 after \$5,500 trade-in and fleet discount; and

Stew Hansen in Urbandale for 2021 Durango at \$28,998 after trade-in and state fleet discounts. RW Pladsen and Torkelson's have a 4-5 month build time for the 2022 pick-ups or SUVs, with no 2021s on the lot. Stew Hansen has 2021 SUVs on their lot.

Sheriff Mellick recommends approving the Stew Hansen quote for 2021 Durango due to price and availability with the intent to use local dealers in the future.

21.418-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to purchase Durango from Stew Hansen at \$28,900 after trade-in. Motion carried.

Jacob Dougherty presented a recommendation from Dr. David Schwartz to be appointed as a Medical Examiner Investigator.

21.419-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to appoint Jacob Dougherty as Medical Examiner Investigator I for Allamakee County. Motion carried.

21.420-Motion Reiser/Second

Byrnes to appoint Jim Magner to Historic Preservation Commission. Motion carried.

Auditor Beyer presented two applications for Business Property Tax Credit that need to be disallowed due to one being residential class - not commercial, and one not qualifying until next year.

21.421-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve two disallowed Business Property Tax Credit applications as presented. Motion carried.

Department Head updates: Engineer Ridenour gave project and department updates. Corey Snitker gave department update, table-top exercise review, and upcoming Commission meeting. Laurie Moody requested AED training for courthouse staff - one member of Waukon Police Department is willing to do this training at no charge. Tentative dates are December 14th and 16th. Sheriff Mellick gave an update on the solar array project and updated water pressure system, as well as advertising for part-time dispatcher. Auditor Beyer updated on requesting American Rescue Plan funds, upcoming worksheets going out for FY23 budget, and Compensation Board meeting December 8. Engineer Ridenour has talked with Grotegut's about both communication and preplanning with Engineer regarding road and weather conditions.
