Auditor Beyer gave department update - 1 COVID positive and 1 negative in her office and office is operating as normal with 3 staff currently. Engineer Ridenour announced the rescheduled meeting for union negotiations; DOT projections for next quarter revenues showing only a 3-4% decrease due to COVID, compared to 6-8% originally estimated.
