Revenue collected in UNINCORPORATED AREAS will be allocated as follows: 40% for Townships'

ed as follows: 40% for Townships' Financial Responsibilities, 30% for Rural Services and 30% for Construction and/or Repair Secondary Roads.

Revenue collected in CITY OF

WAUKON will be allocated as follows: 0% for property tax relief and 100% for construction and reconstruction/repair/replacement of existing streets and curbs, and storm sewer, sanitary sewers, water mains and other structures as they relate to streets within the corporate City limits; public safety vehicle and equipment acquisition.

Revenue collected in CITY OF WATERVILLE will be allocated as follows: Forty percent (40%) for general fund purposes, Forty percent (40%) for public safety and street repairs, Twenty percent (20%) for sewer repairs, replacement and improvement, and zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

Revenue collected in CITY OF POSTVILLE will be allocated as follows: Fifty percent (50%) for public safety, Fifty percent (50%) for street repairs, replacement and improvements, and Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

Revenue collected in CITY OF NEW ALBIN will be allocated as follows: 100% to the general fund.

Reiser to approve today's agenda, removing the 9:40 item, and approve the minutes from December

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting via Zoom or in person: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Dave Mooney, Jared Winger, Kristy Roney, Laurie Moody, Janel Eglseder, Brian Ridenour.
Public Comment: None

Brian Ridenour presented a proposed change to county health insurance, recommended by the county Health Insurance Committee. Brian Huinker with Assured Partners met with Health Insurance Committee recently due to some issues that have came up with UHC Heritage Select claim processing. On UHC end, several providers are being coded as out-of-network, so people are being billed more than they should and correcting the issues is a slow moving, work-intensive process. A technology/computer system alitch is the reason given for the issues. Huinker and the Health Insurance Committee recommend the county make a change to UHC Choice Plus - UHC has seen no issues with this UHC

plan. The recommendation is for 6 months of UHC Choice Plus, to get the county to 7/1/24. The premiums are the same, just a name change and new cards for all. Claims that have been processed as Out-of-Network will be corrected. Janel Eglseder noted that the UHC Choice Plus is just now opening up to Partially Self-Funded, which is how it became available as an option. Allamakee County will be one of the first to change to Choice Plus with the Partially Self-Funded option. Supervisor Keatley and Byrnes thanked Janel for her role in dealing with the issues and appreciates her efforts.

23.450-Motion Reiser/Second Keatley to approve the change for FY24 health insurance, effective January 1, 2024, for county health insurance plans to change from UHC Heritage Select to UHC Choice Plus. Motion carried.

Department Head updates: Dave Mooney gave department update. Laurie Moody gave department update. Learie Moody gave department update. Engineer Ridenour gave phone system update at Engineer's office; gave wage comparisons to Supervisors to review before union negotiations begin. Auditor Beyer gave department update and will be finishing up valuations this week and asked Supervisors to meet next week once valuations are submitted to the state and FY25 property tax limitations are known.
