MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, JUNE 23, 2025 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes, Keatley and Clark. All members voting "AYE" unless noted. Meeting called to order by Byrnes, followed by Pledge of Allegiance. 25.215-Motion Keatlev/Second

Clark to approve today's agenda and minutes from June 16, 2025 meeting. Motion carried. The following people were pres-

ent at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses - Waukon Standard, Denise Beyer Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Destiny Kapler – Postville Herald Nicki Smedsrud, Jon Luchsinger, Stephanie Runkle, Amy Bresnahan, Chris Fee, Corey Snitker, Ryan Delaney.

Public Comment: Stephanie Runkle has checked with other counties about watershed structures and shared her thoughts on mapping it on Beacon: Byrnes has a map he can share. Runkle reported the first application for solar utility will be discussed at Board of Adjustments tomorrow night.

Jon Luchsinger provided Solutions contracts for FY26 and highlighted the changes, price increases of 22%; Harris/Solutions is predicting another 22% increase next year.

25.216-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve signing Solutions contracts for FY26. Motion carried. Tom Clark has spoken with additional vendors to obtain other bids for steam trap replacement. Clark and Beyer will compose an ad for sealed bids and present it for approval next week

Runkle presented plats for approval.

25.217-Motion Clark/Second Keatlev to approve resolution of subdivision plat for Roger Bakewell. Roll call: Clark-aye; Byrnes-aye; Keatlev-ave. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)

25.218-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to approve resolution of subdivision plat for Urell Family Farm. Roll call: Clark-aye; Byrnes-aye; Keatley-aye. Motion carried. (Full text of resolution available in Auditor's office)

Auditor Beyer presented Nationwide 457b document for updated signature.

25.219-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve signing the updated Nationwide 457b agreement. Motion carried.

25.220-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to approve liquor license renewal for Allamakee County Conservation Foundation. Motion carried. Department Head Updates: Luchsinger gave update on CAT6 wiring project. Corey Snitker gave update on heat and potential heavy rain; update on Waukon 100 gravel bike ride; looking at forming a long-term recovery group for disaster recovery; upcoming meetings; adding stop-the-bleed kits to Secondary Road vehicles. Chris Fee, E-911, explained a bill the governor signed-state 911 fund is running out of money and they are reaching to counties to make up the difference, billing quarterly-taking about \$25k total from Allamakee for FY26; the FY26 draws from counties keeps state at zero; when Fee asked "is this forever?" he was told "we'll see what legislators do next year". Treasurer Smedsrud reported on last week's tax sale - maiority of those that didn't sell were mobile homes; tax statement format is being approved; Treasurer office closed July 10 for required training. Engineer Ridenour reminded of 6-county meeting on Thursday in Fredericksburg; new forklift received last week; pavement marking will be done following July 4th holiday; resurfacing project and bid letting updates. Auditor Beyer is preparing for fiscal year-end and new fiscal year.

Engineer Ridenour recommended tabling Secondary Road fund transfers to verify amounts

Ridenour presented in-county quotes for a 2025 Crew Cab 4x4 1500 pickup. Torkelsons quotes for Ram 1500 were \$46,590 for Twin Turbo and \$47,690 for V8 Hemi (9 month to a year wait time for Hemi); Pladsen's Waukon quotes for Chevy 1500 were \$45,911 for Turbo and \$49.319 for V8 Ecotec3 (3-4 month wait time). Ram has longer Powertrain warranty. Ridenour has had good luck with Hemis and recommends the Ram Hemi 5.7L. 25.221-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to approve purchase of a 1500 Ram with 5.7L V8 Hemi engine at \$47,690 from Torkelsons. Motion carried.
