MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, JUNE 27, 2022 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes, Reiser and Schellhammer. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.

Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

22.241-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve today's agenda, tabling the 10:00 item until July 5, and the minutes from June 20, 2022. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses – Waukon Standard, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Jim Magner, Clark Mellick, Corey Snitker, Brian Ridenour, Mike Hohenbrink – Postville Herald.

Public Comment: Jim Magner expressed concern about Four Corners Road and Makee Drive four-way stop – coming from south on Four Corners Road and the hill is so steep it is difficult to stop if you have a load behind you. He would like them to consider possibly removing the north/south stop signs and having just the east/west stops. Brian Ridenour notified Supervisors August 4 is next six-county meeting, and Winneshiek County is repealing their ATV/UTV ordinance.

Val Reinke is still waiting on last piece for RAGBRAI permit application. No action taken.

Secondary Roads transfers presented.

22.242-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve transfers of \$6,102.25 from General Basic Fund to Secondary Roads fund and \$271,773.60 from Rural Basic Fund to Secondary Roads fund. Motion carried.

Reiser to approve liquor license renewals for Allamakee County Conservation Foundation and Sportsmans Club LLC. Motion carried.

Sheriff Mellick informed Supervisors of resignation of dispatcher/jailer Justin Bulleman.

22.244-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to accept resignation of Justin Bulleman, effective July 14, 2022. Motion carried.

Sheriff Mellick requested use of county credit card.

22.245-Motion Byrnes/Second Reiser to approve use of county credit card for purchase of pressure bandages, carry bags, life jackets and throw bags with ropes, with amount not to exceed \$2,600.00. Motion carried.

Sheriff Mellick requested that the Board consider a credit card specific to their department. No action taken. County credit card policy will be reviewed at July 5 meeting and consideration of credit card for Sheriff's department.

Department Head updates: Sheriff Mellick reported the department received their first bill for solar; should start to see Alliant bill go down; gave other department update. Corey Snitker gave Emergency Management department update and upcoming events. Auditor Beyer updated on voter acknowledgment card correction and fiscal year-end this week with meeting at 9am Thursday morning to approve final FY22 claims.
