MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, JUNE 30, 2025 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes. Keatley and Clark. All members voting "AYE" unless noted. Meeting called to order by Byrnes, followed by Pledge of Allegiance. 25.223-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve today's agenda and minutes from June 23, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses - Waukon Standard, Denise Bever - Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Destiny Kapler - Postville Herald, Roger Mohn, Clark Mellick, John Roe, Corey Snitker, Brian Ride nour, Tom Riehm, Scott Numedahl Wick's Construction.

Public Comment: Auditor Beyer shared annual letter from Washington Secretary of the Interior showing amount of \$22,504 for payment-in-lieu-of-taxes from the government.

Notification of electronically filed Manure Management Plan for Chestnut Farm Site 2.

25.224-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to change August 11 claims cycle to August 4 due to required training for Auditor's office staff. Motion carried.

No action on health ins rebate. 25.225-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to appoint Patrick Cota to 3-year term for Veterans Affairs Commission. Motion carried. Supervisor Byrnes reported on

Watershed Inspection reports and a training he took regarding these inspections. Byrnes would like to schedule a work session with interested parties regarding the work related to doing inspections. 25.226-Motion Clark/Second Keatley to sign the 2025 watershed inspection reports. Motion carried. Byrnes presented a letter in support of Iowa's Community Action Agencies and asked for discussion on the topic.

25.227-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to authorize Auditor Denise Beyer to sign online for joining a sign-on letter in support of Iowa's Community Action Agencies. Motion carried.

Supervisor Byrnes stated federal funds are running low for Workforce Development and explained the proposal for a merger of the Iowa Workforce Development Areas. Consensus is Allamakee Supervisors feel the change is inevitable and they have no objection to the merger. Workforce Development will present a document at a later date to approve and sign if all counties report in favor of the merger.

Letter presented by Byrnes in support of the Friends of Yellow River State Forest for their International Dark Sky application. Keatley wants it to be understood there are no restrictions on neighbors and landowners in regards to this designation.

Supervisor Tom Clark reported that they plan to open up the steam trap project for bidding and presented a proposed ad requesting bids.

25.229-Motion Keatley/Second Clark to approve the ad requesting bids for courthouse steam trap replacement as presented and give Supervisor Clark discretion on where ads will be placed. Motion carried.

As awareness regarding County Farm expenses, Supervisor Byrnes and Clark reported they have walked the fences at the County Farm pasture; new renter has pointed out that most of the wood posts have rotted and need to be replaced: County will replace fence posts as necessary and will consider spraying in the fall to prevent thistles and other problem weeds. Sheriff Mellick and Roger Mohn presented contracts and work orders for Public Safety Center water project for approval to get started on designing and manufacturing the fire suppression pump. Continental Fire Sprinkler company auoted \$96.960 for sprinkler, parts and accessories and setup of the entire system.
