MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TUESDAY, JULY 5, 2022 (UNOFFICIAL)

Board members present: Byrnes, Reiser and Schellhammer. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.

Meeting called to order by Schellhammer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

22.249-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve today's agenda, tabling Jill Kistler's item until further notice. Motion carried.

The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting in person: Joseph Moses – Waukon Standard, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Val Reinke, Steve Murray, Mandy O'Neill, Laurie Moody, Clark Mellick, Jenny O'Neill, Brian Ridenour, Deb Winke, Dave Mooney.

Public Comment: Val Reinke talked about RAGBRAI and asked Board of Supervisors if they would like to provide a "welcome" piece for a publication for Day 7 of RAGBRAI, and any help in any community is appreciated for Day 7. Veterans Memorial Postville Clinic opens today.

Steve Murray, Lansing City Council member, presented a request for American Rescue Plan dollars from the county's allocation to help City of Lansing pay for some water and sewer system work that the City was unaware of related to the bridge replacement project. This fall the City of Lansing needs to sign the contract, so the funds need to be obligated by the time the contract is signed. The project will be bid by DOT in Fall 2023. Total of \$240,992.40 is the estimate for the work the City of Lansing is responsible for. City of Lansing has used their ARPA fund allocation for other water and sewer projects. Schellhammer asked how Lansing would pay for it if the county doesn't contribute. Other community development block grants (CDBG) are an option. Murray gave one option of 1/3 grant, 1/3 city and 1/3 county, with \$80,000 contribution from each. Supervisors will talk to Auditor Beyer about where the county is with obligating funds and discuss from there.

Val Reinke presented the application and required documentation for West Paint Creek Synod Cemetery Association's RAGBRAI permit. Laurie Moody talked about food inspector requirements.

22.251-Motion Reiser/Second Byrnes to approve 2022 Resolution for Destruction of Noxious Weeds. Roll call-Reiser-aye; Byrnes-aye; Schellhammer-aye. Motion carried.

Resolution #22.251 RESOLUTION FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF NOXIOUS WEEDS

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Allamakee County, Iowa;

That pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 317 Code of Iowa, 2022, it is hereby ordered:

1. That each owner and each person in the possession or control of any lands in Allamakee County shall properly spray, cut, burn, or otherwise destroy all noxious weeds thereon, as defined in this chapter, at such time in each year and in such manner as shall prevent said weeds from blooming or coming to maturity, and shall keep their lands free from such growth of any weeds as shall render the streets or highways adjoining said land unsafe for public travel. Noxious weeds shall be cut or otherwise destroyed on or before the following dates as often thereafter as it is necessary to prevent seed production:

PRIMARY NOXIOUS WEEDS: JULY 15, 2022 for Buckthorn, Bull thistle, Canada thistle, Field bindweed, Hoary cress (Perennial pepper-grass) Horse nettle, Leafy spurge, musk thistle, Perennial sow thistle, Quack grass, Russian knapweed, Tall thistle & Palmer amaranth

SECONDARY NOXIOUS WEEDS: JULY 15, 2022 for Buckthorn plantain, Cocklebur, Wild sunflower, curly dock, Poison hemlock, Puncturevine, Sheep sorrel, Sour dock, Smooth dock, Teasel, Velvetleaf (Butterprint), Wild carrot, Wild mustard, Multiflora rose and Shattercane.

2. That each owner or each person in the possession or control of land in Allamakee County infested with any noxious weeds shall be expected to destroy and will immediately keep such infestations of said noxious weeds destroyed to prevent the weeds from blooming and maturing additional seeds.

3. That if the owners or persons in possession or control of any land in Allamakee County fail to comply with the foregoing orders, the Weed Commissioner shall cause this to be done and the expense of said work, including cost of serving notice and other cost, if any, shall be assessed against the land and its owners thereof.

4. The multiflora rose shall not be considered a noxious weed when

cultivated for or used as undersod for cultivated roses or as ornamental shrubs in gardens, per Iowa Code Section 317.1 (2).

5. That the Allamakee County Auditor is hereby directed to cause notice of the making and entering of foregoing order by on publication in each of the official newspapers of the County.
