MINUTES OF THE ALLAMAKEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2023 (UNOFFICIAL)
 Board members present: Byrnes, Reiser and Keatley. All members voting "AYE" unless noted.
 Meeting called to order by Byrnes, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
 23.417-Motion Keatley/Second Reiser to approve today's agenda and the minutes from November 20, 2023. Motion carried.
 The following people were present at various times throughout the meeting via Zoom or in person: Joseph Moses – Standard newspaper, Denise Beyer – Auditor and Clerk to Supervisors, Tom Clark, Clark Mellick, John Anderson, Amy Bresnahan, Mike Hohenbrink, Laurie Moody, Brian Ride-nour, Jean Bossom, Tony Gericke, Ross Geerdes.
 Public Comment: None
 John Anderson notified Supervisors that it is time for Collective bargaining. Both units current agreements expire in June 30, 2024. With Sheriff's office, everything can be negotiated. With Secondary Roads, they currently have the full benefits of a CBA, but this is not required. Wages is the only required negotiation item. Anderson reminded Supervisors of their options and there is a new Teamsters union rep, Jeannie Austin. Today is to get negotiations on the radar and set a goal of when we need to start and finish negotiations. Parties are required to exchange initial proposals in open session. Actual negotiations take place in closed session and meet with the union rep. Anderson needs to know an initial idea of where the Supervisors want to start. End of January/beginning of February is when an agreement needs to be reached – otherwise it needs to go to arbitration or mediation.

 Attorney Gericke was unable to return following closed session – no action on 10:00 item.
 Plat approvals were presented for approval by Laurie Moody; Runkle was not able to return following the closed session.

 Auditor Beyer presented 2024 County holidays for approval.
 24.421-Motion Reiser/Second Keatley to approve 2024 County holidays. Motion carried.
 Auditor Denise Beyer informed Supervisors of the end of the probationary period for Kim Engrav, Real Estate Clerk, and requested approval of a \$0.50/hour increase, effective November 23, 2023.
 24.422-Motion Keatley/Second Reiser to grant a \$0.50/hour raise effective November 23 for Real Estate Clerk Kimberly Engrav. Motion carried.
 Department Head updates: Ross Geerdes gave department update. Laurie Moody gave department update. Auditor Beyer gave update on deadlines and projects in her office and plan to send out FY25 budget worksheets after November month-end process is completed; also notified Supervisors of her appointment to Local Leadership Council through Election Assistance Commission which is a group of election officials nationwide who meet virtually every quarter and once a year in person to share information and ideas about election administration.
 Supervisors went to Harpers Ferry with Conservation Director Ross Geerdes to look at Conservation buildings.
